

BLOOD PRESSURE CUFF/MONITOR KITS

High blood pressure, also known as hypertension, raises your risks for heart attack, stroke, diabetes, and kidney disease.

Now at your library, thanks to Spencer Community Health and the Spencer Public Library, customers can check out electronic blood pressure monitoring kits.

Guidelines for Borrowing and Use-

- Customers must be 18 years of age or older to checkout a BP Cuff/Monitor Kit.
- A valid SPL account AND a current driver's license, state ID, passport, or military photo ID must be presented at the time of checkout.
- Customer must be in good standing with the library, with a current address on file, and must not be blocked due to overdue items.
- BP Cuff Kits may be checked out for two weeks (14 days).
- Holds may be blocked, and 1 renewal is allowed if there are no holds on the item.
- BP Cuff Kits must be returned in person to the library, not placed in the library book drops.

Fines and Liability-

- The overdue fine is \$0.50 per day until returned.
- Customers may be charged repair/replacement fees for devices not returned in person to the library.
- The BP Cuff Kit should be kept in a temperature controlled environment; do not leave it in your car.
